Regional cooperation in the context of the new stage of relations between Russia and China

In the modern conditions, the role and importance of bilateral relations between Russia and China is rapidly increasing, therefore, the search for new, effective solutions in this area is necessary. Particular attention is attracted to the improvement in the perspective of cooperation between the border areas. The experience gained over the decades (both positive and negative) makes it possible to intensify the existing tools of interregional economic interaction, as well as to form the new institutional approaches. Directions for the future development of relations between the Russian Far East and the Northeastern China, which are being developed and discussed, are not only aimed at solving the local development problems, but also to a large extent contain the answers to the expected macroeconomic risks associated with changes in the future characteristics of the development of both countries.
