The Far Eastern youth as a subject and object of the state policy

The article presents an analysis of statistical data and sociological research results that characterize the situation of young people in the Far East of Russia. The article makes a conclusion about the growing crisis of social relations, deformation of the continuity of generations, the mismatch of needs and the possibilities of satisfying them with the young people. Despite the taken measures, statistics and the results of sociological studies indicate negative trends in the migration attitudes of the Far East. Over the past three decades, there has been a rapid decline in the proportion of young people in the Russian Far East due to the migration outflow. The region needs a special national policy not only on the macro-development of the region, but also on improving the standard of living of a particular person. The most obvious measures of "securing" and attracting people to the Far East of the country participants consider economic incentives: the growth of real family incomes, the possibility of improving their living conditions, the opportunity to receive good education and employment of young people, as well as opportunities for self-realization of children and youth.
