Impact of living standards on the formation of migration attitudes

The article is devoted to the analysis of the influence of the standard of living of the population on the formation of migration attitudes. The relevance of studying the factors of formation of migration attitudes of the population is confirmed by the continued outflow of the population from the territory, despite government programs and projects in the region to attract and retain the population. The article presents the results of a large-scale sociological study of the population of the Far Eastern region, examines the main trends in assessing the standard of living of population and migration attitudes, as a potential readiness for migration. It is noted that the main reasons for leaving are associated with various conditions, which are largely determined by the standard of living: with getting a better education, looking for a better job, more decent wages, better living conditions.
