Migration intentions of residents of the Khabarovsk territory: declared the trend or the objective reality

The article presents the results of sociological studies on the study of migration attitudes of residents of the Khabarovsk territory. The study revealed migration facilities, the reasons for their formation, as well as a list of priority socio-economic measures, the implementation of which the respondents are willing to stay in the Khabarovsk territory. Taking into account the special attention of the authorities to the city of presidential attention (Komsomolsk-on-the Amur), the article analyzes the results of a survey of city residents on assessing the level of satisfaction with the current situation and determining factors of population outflow. Using the obtained survey results, as well as data from the federal state statistics on population size and migration outflow from the region, a direct correlation dependence of the studied phenomena was revealed. Taking into account the results of sociological surveys of recent years presented in the article, which record the migratory moods of residents of the Khabarovsk territory, measures can be offered to the social unit by the National Program for the Development of the Far East for the period up to 2025, aimed at raising the standard of living of the population and transforming the socio-economic conditions in region.
